





## Religious Education in Class 1

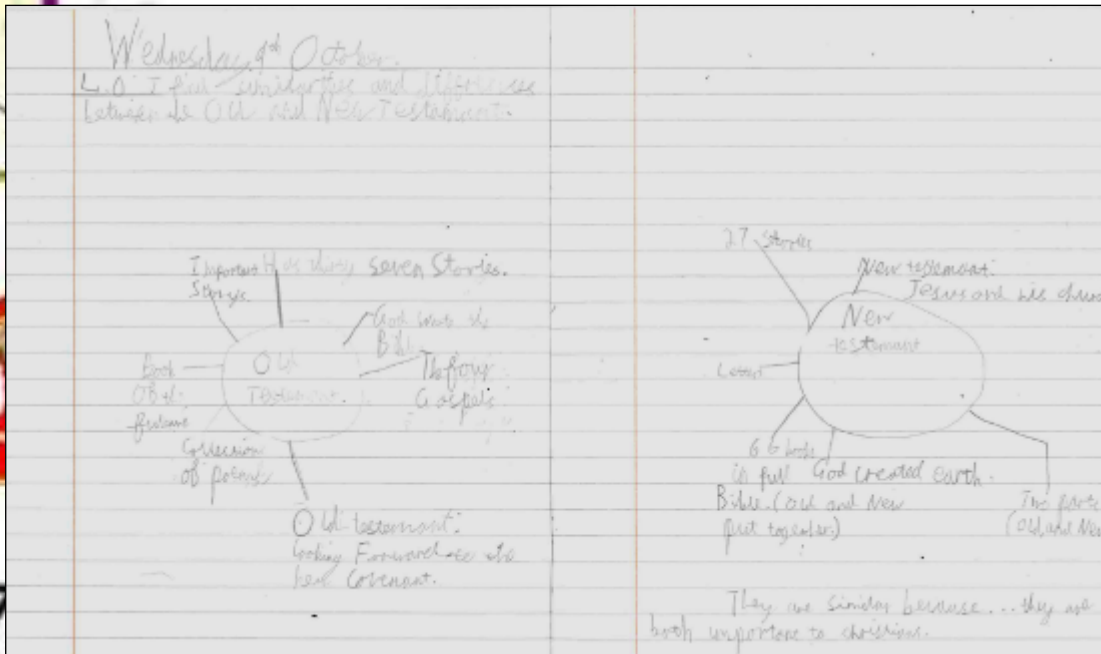

## Religious Education in Class 2

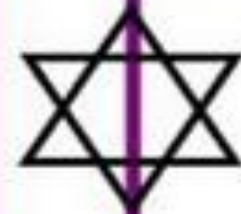
This term the R.E topic for Class 2 is 'Where do religious beliefs come from?', looking at Christianity as their focus.

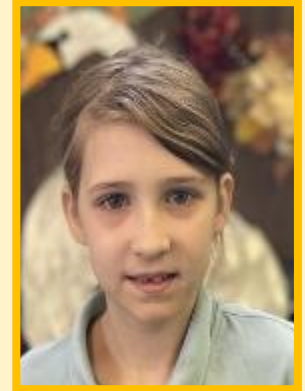
