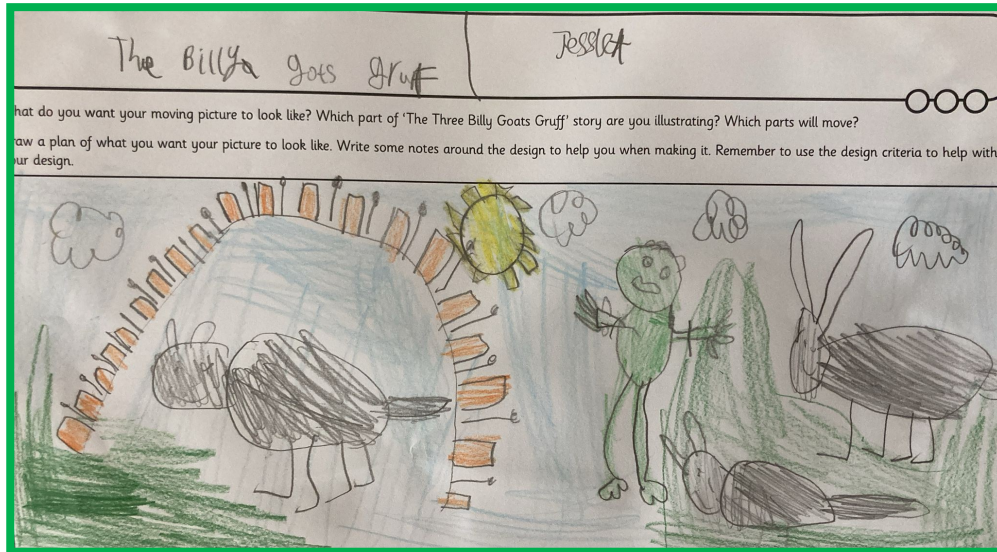


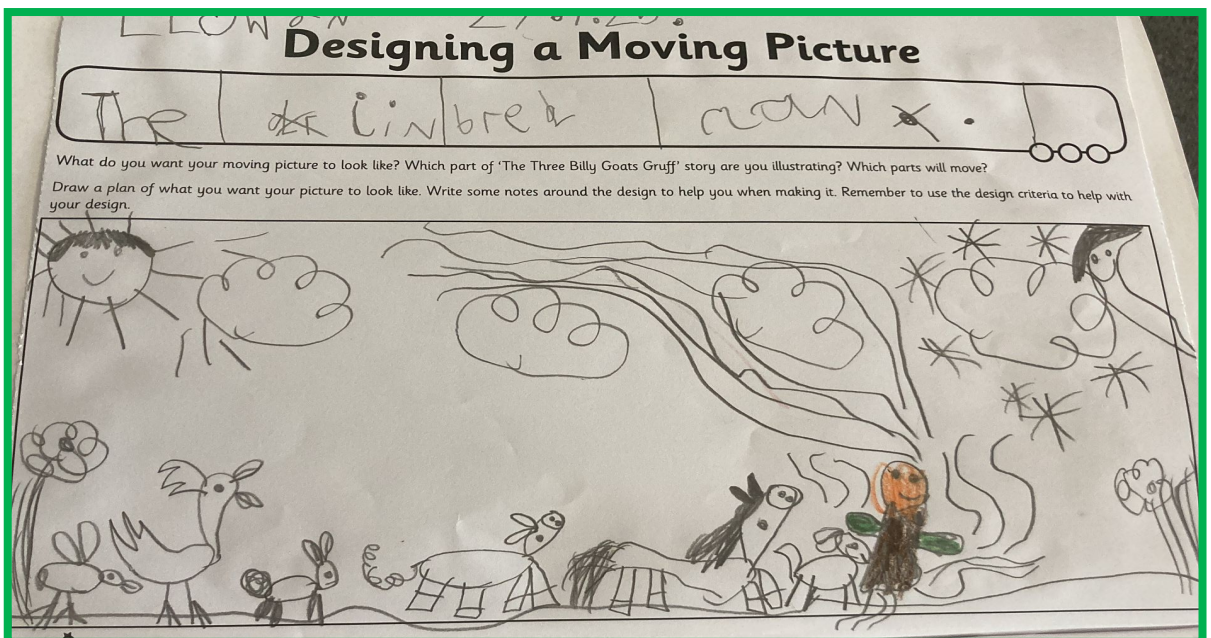
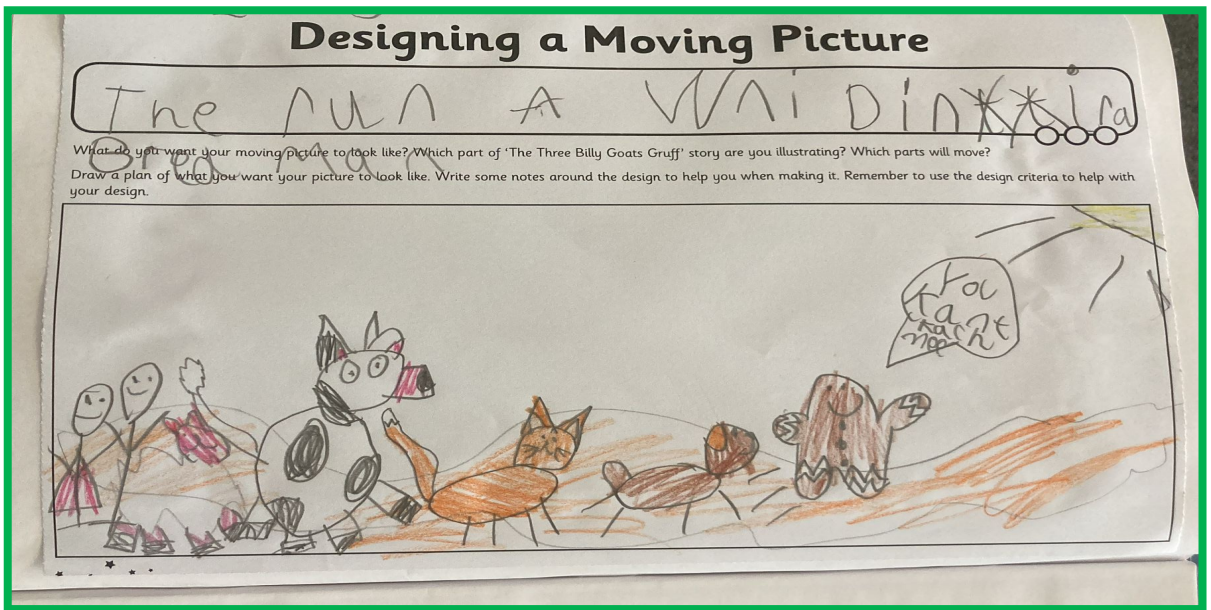

1) It would sound and look fun if it was a different setting. Because otherwise people wouldn't get sent there their if they weren't it wasn't a bad place.

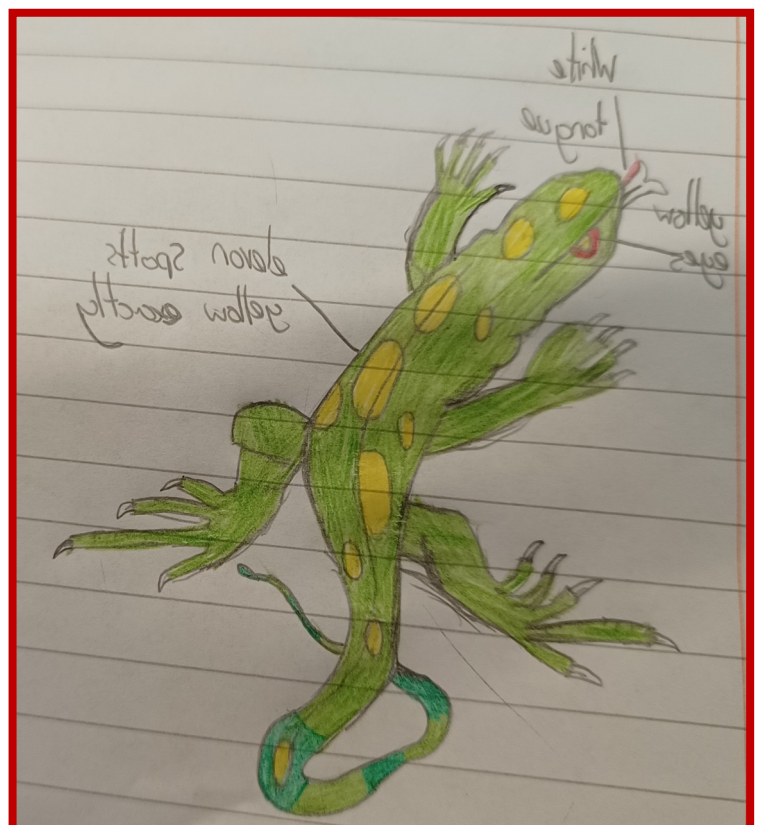

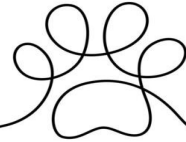
